06. Depression era bisquit barrel, “Madrid” pattern, circa 1930-35, lidded, minor chip. \$250.

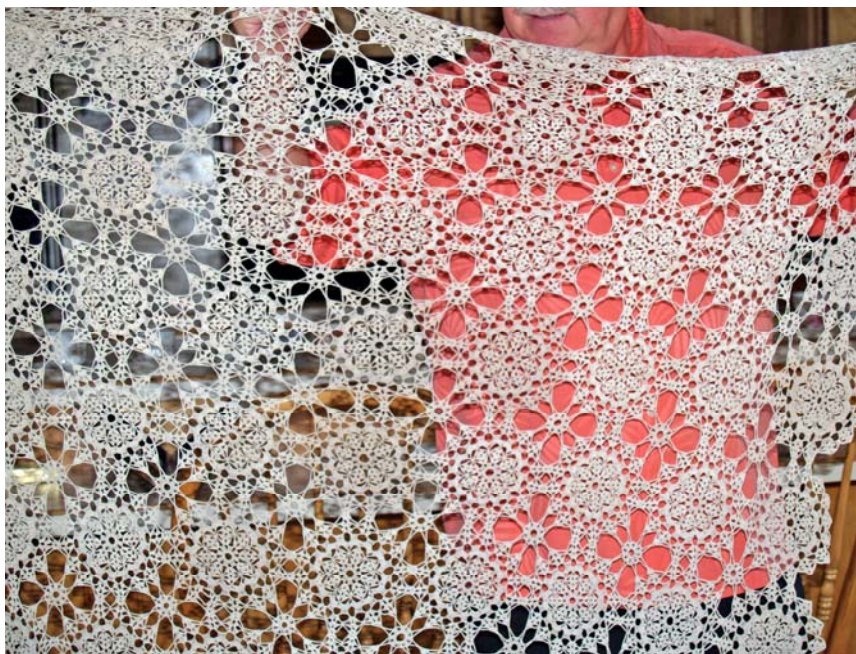

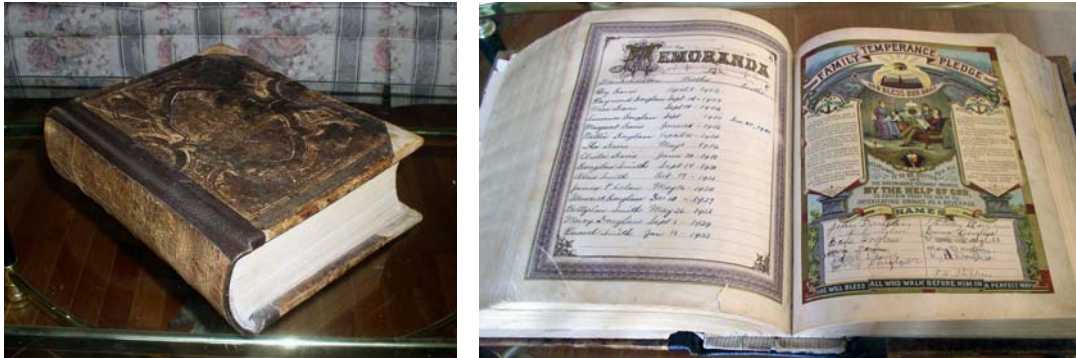
